

At the Public Hearing held in the Council Chambers by the City Council, June 20, 2016, the following proceedings were held and entered in this record in the following words and figures to wit:

The Mayor called the Public Hearing to order at 6:30 P.M.

Roll Call - Aldermen Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Heberling, Olive, Jones and Walters were present. Alderman Vota was absent.

Also in attendance were Mayor Brotherton, Deputy City Clerk Cindy Dey, Joe Hauser, Pat Kretzer, Mike Welge, Jim Altman, Scott McClure, Alan Collebrusco, Steve Breckenridge, George Calvert, City Attorney Romano, Neal Lebeter, and Pastor Gerald McPhillips.

The Mayor announced that the purpose of the Public Hearing before the City Council and Plan Commission was to allow everyone to speak in favor or against granting a Special Use to Grace Baptist Church to build a 66' X 60' addition onto the Worship Center of the existing structure and add a 36' X 55' hallway to join the old and new structures together. The property is located at 900 Northern Avenue, Taylorville, Illinois, presently zoned as Residential 2 (R-2).

The Mayor asked for comments or questions from the Council.

Alderman Walters stated he had reviewed all the information and has no objection to the Special Use.

Alderman Jones questioned why the church is required to apply for a Special Use. According to the Taylorville City Code Section 10-4-3-7 churches located in a Residential-1 and/or Residential-2 District are required to apply for a Special Use.

The Mayor asked for comments or questions from the audience. There were none.

Motion by Alderman Jones and seconded by Alderman Burtle to adjourn. Motion carried (7-0).
