MUNICIPAL BUILDING MASONRY REPAIRS

Chairman Koonce reported that the leak on the roof of the Municipal Building turned out to be a plumbing problem not a roofing problem and has been taken care of to City Engineer Joe Greene's satisfaction. Joe Greene approved payment to the roofing contractor.

Motion by Alderman Walters and seconded by Alderman Heberling to approve the payment of \$11,070.00 to Evans-Mason, Inc. for City of Taylorville Municipal Building Masonry Repairs. Motion carried 4-0. This amount represents 10 percent retainage.
