Chairman Vota called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

LEASE OF LAKE PROPERTY

Two requests for leasing of Lake Taylorville property for hunting have recently been approved. Committee members will discuss the merits of offering others area for hunting and possibly have a procedure in place that would be more beneficial to the City.

Superintendent Jackson informed the Committee that he has had several calls from interested people since the item appeared on the agenda. He presented a map showing thirteen areas possibly designated with bow or shotgun hunting and placement of houses in the areas. He feels we know the boundaries so no surveys should be needed. For safety reasons most sites would not be available for hunting until after November when the Lake closes. Bow hunting will be prohibited 100 yards from any home. Hunters would have to provide adequate liability insurance. City residents may be given first chance. Revenue would be applied to the Lake Restoration Line Item.

Mike and Mark Coady object to the use of the City Property adjacent to their land and feel all adjacent land owners of all Lake properties offered for hunting should be notified. He stated the property is land locked but was informed it can be accessed by the Lake road.

This matter will be placed on next month's agenda.

MARINA OFFICE BUILDING UPGRADES-AWARD BID

Two bids were received for the Lake Marina Office Building Upgrades for Heating, Cooling, Electrical and Roofing.

Motion by Walters and seconded by Alderman Budd to recommend to the City Council to accept the bid from Yard Heating & Cooling for the Lake Taylorville Marina Office Building Upgrades of Heating, Cooling, Electrical and Roofing in the amount of \$19,585.00. Motion carried 3-0.
