Ordinance –

Motion to direct the City Attorney to prepare an Ordinance to amend the Taylorville City Code Section 8-5-4-I to state that the property owner is responsible for the expense for maintenance and repair of the sewer line up to and including the main tap. The City will reimburse 50% of the cost of repairs up to a job total of \$3,500.00 and a depth of excavation of 10 feet, based on criteria, inspection and deemed necessary by the Street and Sewer Superintendent. If a residence sewer line repair requires more than a 10 foot excavation depth, these cases will be handled on a case by case basis and also with any recommendations from the City Attorney

Motion to direct the City Attorney to amend Section 9-1-1-E of the Taylorville City Code as proposed by the City Attorney regarding terms and conditions of a building permit

Motion to direct the City Attorney to prepare an Ordinance regarding private sanitary sewage disposal within the City Limits
