Salary Raises – Police Dispatchers

Kayleigh Boston addressed the Committee on behalf of the Dispatchers. Dispatcher Boston explained the Department had recently gone through some staffing issues leaving the Dispatchers to work 60 plus hour weeks. There is also a lot of legal responsibility and requirements as a Dispatcher. Currently the Christian County Sheriff's Department is offering a higher pay and some of the City Dispatchers have considered applying there because of the income difference. Chairman Driskell explained that things need to go through the proper channels and raises could be discussed during negotiations. Chairman Driskell and Alderman Bryant expressed how much they appreciate the work and dedication the Dispatchers have for the City.

Hire Replacement Firefighter

Chief Adermann advised the Committee that Firefighter Wamsley is planning to retire at the beginning of the year and he would like to get the process started to hire a replacement.

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Olive to recommend to the City Council to approve to hire one Firefighter for the Taylorville Fire Department. Motion carried 4-0.
