ACCEPT QUOTE INSERT VALVE

The Council acknowledged that the quote for the insert valve was previously approved at the November 17 Council Meeting.

AWARD BIDS FOR FIRE HYDRANTS

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Hagen to recommend to the City Council to accept and award the low bid for 16 Mueller Super Centurion Fire Hydrants for the Water Treatment Plant to IMCO in the amount of \$61,368.00. Motion carried 3-0.

AWARD BIDS FOR PVC PIPE

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Hagen to recommend to the City Council to accept and award the low bid for 500' of 6" C900 DR 18 PVC for the Water Treatment Plant to Midwest Meter in the amount of \$4,185.00. Motion carried 3-0.

PURCHASE BECK ACTUATOR

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Hagen to recommend to the City Council to approve the purchase of a 11-263 and a 11-269 Actuator from Beck Electric at a cost not to exceed \$15,000.00

WATER COLLECTION OFFICE UPDATE

Superintendent Brune provided the January 2026 Water Collection Office update.

REVIEW/AMEND CITY CODE 8-4-1F

Motion by Alderman Budd seconded by Alderman Hagen to recommend forwarding a proposed amendment to City Code Section 8-4-1(F) to the Ordinance Committee for review and approval, said amendment to revise the fee to \$2,000.00 per property and to assume responsibility for installation of the service line and meter pit from the water main. Motion carried 3-0.


WATER SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT
