#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Alderman Brown and seconded by Alderman Olive to utilize the Omnibus Vote Designation for various meetings. Roll Call – Aldermen Brown, Budd, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, and Wilson voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 4155 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPH C. OF SECTION 7-1-4 OF THE TAYLORVILLE CITY CODE (NO WINTER STORAGE RENTAL FEE FOR BOAT DOCKS RE: LAKE LOT OR CAMPSITE LEASES)

Motion by Alderman Driskell and seconded by Alderman Broqn to approve Ordinance No. 4155 – An Ordinance Amending Subparagraph 7-1-4 of the Taylorville City Code (no winter storage rental fee for boat docks re: lake lot or campsite leases). Roll Call – Aldermen Brown, Budd, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, Wilson, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 4156 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBPARGRAPH B. OF SECTION 3-15-4 TO THE TAYLORVILLE CITY CODE (RE: INCREASING ANNUAL VIDEO GAMING TERMINAL PERMIT FEE TO \$250.00)

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to approve Ordinance No. 4156 – An Ordinance Amending Subparagraph B. of Section 3-15-4 to the Taylorville City Code (re: increasing annual video gaming terminal permit fee to \$250.00). Roll Call – Aldermen Brown, Budd, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. Alderman Wilson voted NAY. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 4157 – AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 2455 (RE: REMOVAL OF THE NO PARKING RESTRICTION ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE 200 BLOCK OF WEST ESTHER STREET)

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Skultety to approve Ordinance No. 4157 – An Ordinance Rescinding Ordinance No. 2455 (re: removal of the no parking restriction on the South side of the

200 block of West Esther Street). Roll Call – Aldermen Brown, Budd, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, Wilson, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 4158 – AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 REDEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN CITY OF TAYLORVILLE, ILLINOIS AND THE VINTAGE DRESSER, LLC AND RACHEL GRIFFIN AND JUSTIN GRIFFIN

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Skultety to approve Ordinance No. 4158 – An Ordinance Approving and Authorizing the Execution of a Business Development District No. 1 Redevelopment Agreement by and between City of Taylorville, Illinois and The Vintage Dresser, LLC and Rachel Griffin and Justin Griffin. Roll Call – Aldermen Brown, Budd, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, Wilson, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

SMALL TOWN TAYLORVILLE 2023 CALENDAR OF EVENTS/SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT

Motion by Alderman Driskell and seconded by Alderman Wilson to approve the 2023 Calendar of Events and issue a Special Events Permit for Small Town Taylorville. Aldermen Brown, Budd, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, and Wilson voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF ABBY TURNER – LIBRARY BOARD

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Olive to approve the Mayor's Appointment of Abby Turner to the Library Board. The motion carried (7-0).

SOLAR PROJECT CONDITION CLOSURE PERMIT – WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Motion by Alderman Wilson and seconded by Alderman Budd to approve the Conditional Closure Permit for the solar array energy system at the City's Water Treatment Plant Site in the form as prepared and presented by City Attorney Romano, or in such other form as he may recommend and which may be approved by the Mayor. Roll Call – Aldermen Brown, Budd, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, and Wilson voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

PURCHASE OF WACHS TC 100 CONTROLLER – SCHULTE SUPPLY

Motion by Alderman Dorchinecz and seconded by Alderman Driskell to approve the purchase of a Wachs TC 100 Controller from Schulte Supply at a cost not to exceed \$4,085.00. Roll Call – Aldermen Brown, Budd, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, and Wilson voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Brown to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented. The motion carried (7-0).

PAYMENT OF BILLS

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Bryant to authorize payment of bills. Alderman Budd discussed the unemployment benefits paid to two Summer/Seasonal employees and one terminated employee. He stated that unemployment benefits are to be paid only for three Permanent Part-time employees/positions, not Summer Seasonal workers. This should have been contested by the Human Resource Manager. This will be addressed moving forward through the Personnel Committee. Roll Call – Aldermen Brown, Budd, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, and Wilson voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.
