MOTION TO APPROVE THE FINAL 2023-2024 AND THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 AUDIT AS PRESENTED BY SIKICH

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Dennis to approve the final 2023-2024 and the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Audit as presented by Sikich.

MOTION TO RECOMMEND TO THE CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE THE LAKE LOT AND CAMPGROUND LEASE INCREASE
