## APPROVE LOWEST QUOTE FROM JOHN DEERE TO PURCHASE A 2032R COMPACT UTILITY TRACTOR WITH A 220R LOADER AND A 53" GRAPPLE BUCKET

Motion by Board Member Ward and seconded by Board Member Hoffman to recommend to the City Council to accept the lowest quote from John Deere to purchase a 2032R compact utility tractor with a 220R loader and a 53" grapple bucket, at a cost not to exceed \$33,500 with funds coming from perpetual care interest funds. Motion carried 3-0.

## PURCHASE A 2026 F150 TRUCK

Motion by Board Member Ward and seconded by Board Member Hoffman to recommend to the City Council to approve the purchase of a 2026 ½ ton F150 truck from Bob Ridings Fleet Sales at the price not to exceed \$49,500.00 with funds coming from perpetual care interest funds. Motion carried 3-0.

## PURCHASE OF A 2027 JOHN DEERE X-750 RIDING MOWER

Motion by Board Member Hager and seconded by Board Member Hoffman to recommend to the City Council to approve the purchase of a 2027 John Deere X-750 Riding Lawn Mower and the 2027 John Deere X750 auto connect deck from Sloan Implement in Edinburg at a cost not to exceed \$ 15,000.00 to be paid from the Perpetual Care Interest Fund. Motion carried 3-0.

## APPROVE FISCAL YEAR 2026/2027 BUDGET

Superintendent Tennant presented the FY 2026/2027 budget to the Board.

Motion by Board Member Hager and seconded by Board Member Hoffman to accept and refer the proposed Fiscal Year 2026/2027 Oak Hill Cemetery Budget to the Finance Committee. Motion carried 3-0.

Superintendent Tennant presented a listing of prices for Opening, Grave, and Cremation for several area cemeteries and a listing of suggested price increases for review and discussion.

Motion by Board Member Hoffman and seconded by Board Member Ward to make the increases as follows effective 5/1/2026.
