**SUESSIE'S RESALE REQUESTING TO CLOSE S MAIN FOR BLOCK PARTY
FUNDRAISER SEPT 11-13**

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Dennis to recommend to the City Council to approve the Special Events Permit for Suessie's Resale. Motion carried 3-1.

PROPOSED RESOLUTION REGARDING PAPER MILL BRANCH

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Dennis to recommend to the City Council to direct the City Clerk to prepare a Joint Resolution with Christian County for the Paper Mill Branch infrastructure project, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00, with funds to be paid from the MFT Fund, and to waive all statutory bidding requirements. Motion carried 4-0.

PURCHASE OF TRUCKS

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Dennis to recommend to the City Council approval of the purchase of one (1) 2023 Ford F-750 Bucket Truck, two (2) single axle trucks, (1) pickup Truck and a Bobcat to be financed through the bank offering the lowest interest rate, in an amount not to exceed \$750,000.00, and to waive all statutory bidding requirements. Motion carried 4-0.

WEST MAIN CROSS

Benton & Associates provided an update on the status of the West Main Cross water main replacement project and ongoing progress.

ACCEPT BIDS OF CONCRETE, SIDEWALKS, CURB & CUTTERING AND FUEL

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Driskell to recommend to the City Council to accept the bid from Poggenpohl LLC of \$178.00 per cubic yard for curb and guttering, and \$174.00 per cubic yard for sidewalks. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Driskell to recommend to the City Council to accept the bid from R&B Peters of \$6.25 per square foot for Sidewalk Replacement, and \$31.00 per linear foot for curb and guttering. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Driskell to recommend to the City Council to accept the bid from Christian County Farmers Supply Company for:

On Road Biodiesel (B2) up to 21,000 gallons at \$4.253 per gallon
On Road Biodiesel Winter Grade (B2) up to 21,000 gallons at \$4.313 per gallon

Off Road Biodiesel (B2) up to 16,700 gallons at \$3.698 per gallon
Off Road Biodiesel Winter Grade (B2) up to 16,700 gallons at \$3.758 per gallon
Regular Unleaded Grade Gasoline up to 44,000 gallons at \$3.187 per gallon

Motion carried 4-0.

EASEMENT FOR NORTHERN AVENUE – SOLAR FARM

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Dennis to recommend to the City Council approval of the installation of a culvert on Northern Avenue, contingent upon the City being reimbursed for all time and materials. Motion carried 3-1.

BUDGET

Superintendent Mann presented the FY 2026/2027 Street and Sewer Budgets.

Motion by Alderman Dennis and seconded by Alderman Driskell to recommend to the City Council to forward the Fiscal Year 2026/2027 Street and Sewer budgets to the Finance Committee. Motion carried 4-0.

ADDITIONAL CAMERA'S THROUGH WAREHAM'S SECURITY

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Dennis to recommend to the City Council to accept the proposal from Wareham's Security and have (2) new cameras installed at a cost of \$2,499.00 for parts and labor. Motion carried 4-0.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT


Superintendent Mann reported that City crews have been engaged in various projects throughout the City. He advised that a limb pick-up will be conducted in each Ward during the month of April. He also noted that crews have been cleaning ditches.

ANY OTHER MATTERS

Alderman Driskell requested that all City departments provide maintenance schedules for all equipment.

Superintendent Mann reported that he received an email from Brian Lynch regarding a couple of benches that were donated to the bike trail.
