

Minutes of the Plan Commission Meeting

April 6, 2026

Chairman Kretzer called the meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. in conjunction with a public hearing with the Taylorville City Council. Roll call showed the following members present: Pat Kretzer, Kevin Hamell, Matthew Yard, Tony Verardi, Scott McClure and Toddy Altman; excused: Sam Peabody.

The Mayor read the purpose of the meeting: to consider and ordinance making amendments to the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Taylorville, Illinois by amending subparagraph A of Section 10-6-2 of Title 10 of the Taylorville City Code to add certain outdoor billboards or signs as a Special Use in and I-2 (Industrial) Zoning District on private property located outside of the Taylorville Commercial and Industrial Park.

Daniel Hamilton, legal counsel for Lamar Outdoor Advertising, spoke in support of the change. His company is looking to erect a sign on property that would be allowed with the proposed change, and they would look to apply for a Special Use Permit.

Chairman Kretzer encouraged the City to look at further ordinance updates covering the use of digital signage.

A motion was made by Mr. Hammell to recommend that the City Council adopt the changes to the ordinance. Mr. Altman seconded; roll call vote showed all members voting in favor of the motion.

With no other business, a meeting to adjourn was made by Mr. Hamell and seconded by Mr. Altman. Meeting adjourned at 6:38 p.m.
