FENCE REPAIR

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Dennis to recommend to the City Council to approve the fence repair at the Street Dept from AMCO Fence Co. at a cost of \$6,860.00. Motion carried 4-0.

EMERGENCY SEWER REPAIR

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Olive to recommend to the City Council approval of the emergency sewer repairs, including the removal and replacement of the existing sewer, to be completed by Petersburg Plumbing at a cost of \$134,688.00. Motion carried 4-0.
