CEMETERY SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent Tennant provided the Cemetery Superintendent's report. In the month of May, there were 7 burials, 4 were cremations. We had 4 grave sales. We have been mowing and weed eating. We will soon begin clearing overgrown brush and vegetation along the perimeter of the cemetery. He also reported that a ribbon-cutting ceremony was held for the new Columbarium to formally introduce the structure to the public
