


At the Special Council meeting held in the Council Chambers by the City Council, June 4, 2026, the following proceedings were held and entered in this record in the following words and figures to wit:

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M.

Roll Call – Aldermen Brown, Bryant, Budd, Dennis, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive and Hagen were present.

The Mayor announced this meeting was in reference to DECO Rebuild Downtown & Main Streets. Benton Engineering presented maps and plans for the construction. Bill Sleeman from Benton explained the plans and answered questions and concerns from citizens and business owners.

David Brummer spoke explaining that he as a building located at 141 E. Main Cross in which he is willing to construct a Public Restroom. He stated that he would maintain the restroom with the city only paying for the water, hand towels and toilet paper. The restroom would be open during the daytime 365 days a year. The cost to the city would be \$750.00 per month.

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Driskell to adjourn the meeting. The Mayor announced the motion carried 8-0.
