Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Olive to approve Ordinance No. 4051—Ordinance Authorizing the Purchase of Personal Property (i.e. Tracked 44" Rotary Mower, 21.5 hp Kawasaki Engine, 45 Degrees Max Slope), for a total price of \$37,700.00; and to waive all statutory bidding requirements.
