

At the Public Hearing held in the Council Chambers by the City Council, July 18, 2022, the following proceedings were held and entered in this record in the following words and figures to wit:

The Mayor called the Public Hearing to order at 6:45 P.M.

Roll Call - Aldermen Brown, Bryant, Budd, Dorchinecz, Olive, Skultety, and Wilson were present. Alderman Driskell was absent.

Also present were Mayor Barry, City Attorney Romano, City Clerk Lilly (via Zoom), Superintendent Brune, Water Office Manager Hamell, William Sleeman, and Randy Miller.

Mayor Barry announced that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to consider the Annual Appropriations Ordinance for the Fiscal Year commencing May 1, 2022 and ending April 30, 2023.

The total amount of the Appropriations Ordinance as prepared is \$36,574,930.00. Finance Chairman Budd noted that the Police, Fire, and Administration Grant Lines should be increased by \$2,000,000.00 each, for a total of \$6,000,000.00, to cover grants that may or may not be received this fiscal year. This will cover the City's ability to receive and spend those grant funds, if awarded.

Mayor Barry asked if there were any questions from the Council or from the audience. There were none.

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried (7-0).

The Public Hearing adjourned at 6:49 P.M.
