

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Taylorville will hold a public hearing on August 17th, 2026, at 6:30 PM, at City Hall to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federal funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons who wish to attend the public hearing and need assistance should contact Jolynne Richardson at 115 North Main, Taylorville, IL or (217) 824-2101 no later than August 14th, 2026. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about August 27th, 2026, City of Taylorville intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: Replacement of a water main under Rte. 48 at E. Main Cross Street. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$912,450. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-to-moderate income persons is \$559,331.85.

Information related to this project will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of August 6, 2026 at the City Hall, 115 North Main, Taylorville, Illinois between the hours of 8:30-4:00. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to Jolynne Richardson at 115 North Main, Taylorville, IL 62568 no later than August 14th in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by the City of Taylorville and is also available to the public. This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses.
