Chairman Hagen called the meeting to order at 6:34 P.M.

### BYOB DISCUSSION

Chairman Hagen wanted to keep an open discussion for this matter. Regarding the City Code 3-3-5 Class L License our current verbiage states "Licenses issued pursuant to this classification shall permit a City liquor license holder to additionally apply for such Class L "special use permit" license ... The committee discussed revising the language to allow holders of a County Liquor License to obtain a Class L License. The committee further discussed establishing a fee of \$50.00 for City Liquor License holders and \$100.00 for County liquor license holders obtaining a Class L License.

Motion by Alderman Budd seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to Recommend to City Council to direct the City Clerk to amend Section 3-3-5 of the City Code regarding the Class L License to allow County liquor license holders to obtain a Class L license and to establish a fee of \$50.00 for City liquor license holders and \$100.00 for County liquor license holders. Motion Carried 3-0.

### SECOND OFFENSE ORDINANCE VIOLATION

### CONTRACTOR START TIME

Motion by Alderman Dorchinecz seconded by Alderman Budd to Recommend to City Council to amend the City Code 8-1-G-16-D-3 regarding construction hours be amended to provide that the Mayor or Street and Sewer Superintendent may authorize construction hours outside of the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M., Monday through Saturday, in place of the current language stating, "Unless otherwise permitted by the City". Motion Carried 3-0.

### NO WAKE ZONE AFTER SUNSET

Superintendent Ortman discussed safety concerns of watercrafts speeding after sunset.

Motion by Alderman Dorchinecz seconded by Alderman Budd to Recommend to City Council to direct the City Attorney to prepare an ordinance establishing a no wake zone for any and all watercraft after sunset. The proposed ordinance shall provide for violation fees of \$250.00 for a first offense, \$500.00 for a second offense, and \$750.00 for a third and each subsequent offense. Motion Carried 3-0.

**DISCUSS UPDATES TO LAKE RULES & REGULATIONS**

This matter will be discussed further at September's Ordinance committee meeting to allow the committee ample time to review the proposed changes. No further action was taken.

**HBO UPDATE**

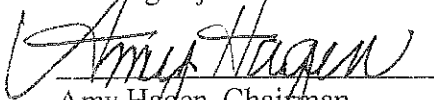
