

At the Public Hearing held in the Council Chambers by the City Council, September 5, 2023, the following proceedings were held and entered in this record in the following words and figures to wit:

The Mayor called the Public Hearing to order at 6:30 P.M.

Roll Call - Aldermen Brown, Bryant, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, and Wilson were present.

Also present were Mayor Barry, City Clerk Lilly, City Treasurer Miles, City Attorney Romano (via zoom), Superintendents Brune, Mann, and Ortman, HBO Goodall, Jim Morris, Tavia Leach and Nic Nelson, Attorney representing Jacob & Klein, Ltd.

Mayor Barry announced that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to consider the Third Amendment to the Business Development District No. 1. Attorney Nic Nelson, representing Jacob and Klein, Ltd., stated that this amendment will add 85 parcels to the Business Development District on East Franklin, Market and Main Cross. A small number parcels are vacant, while the majority have buildings located on the property. There is a qualifying number of blighted properties. The termination date will be 23 years from the original date; this amendment does not extend the date. The area will now incur an additional 1% tax.

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Brown to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried (7-0).
