Ordinance -

Motion to recommend to the City Council to divide the surplus or overage of the Street Maintenance Fund 5 ways; one-fifth to each Ward and one-fifth to a Common Street Account. Once this account reached a balance of \$300,000.00, any monies distributed to the Street Maintenance Fund will be divided 4 ways, equally amongst the 4 Wards

Motion to recommend to the City Council to direct the City Attorney to amend the Taylorville City Code to incorporate into Title 3 Section 2-4 the Municipal Tax Money Procedure as presented with the following amendment to #3: The Street Maintenance Fund represents the total amount of monies that is divided 5 ways equally: one-fifth to each Ward and one-fifth to a Common Street Account

Finance -

Motion to recommend to the City Council to contribute \$5,000.00 to the Christian County Senior Citizens

Motion to recommend to the City Council to enter into an Agreement with the firm represented by Mr. Doug McDermith, as suggested by Ms. Mary Renner, based upon a clarification of item #2 of the Agreement and present to the City Attorney for review (in regards to the Enterprise Zone)

Motion to recommend to the City Council to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented

Public Facilities -

Motion to recommend to the City Council to allow Phil Tullis to do the demolition and removal of the old concrete and replace the concrete at the Municipal Building, with the City paying for the concrete; allow Alderman Olive to have handrails installed and Morrison Electric to install lighting, with the cost of the project not to exceed \$17,500.00 subject to the funds being available and approved by the Treasurer

Street & Sewer -

- Motion to recommend to the City Council to approve the request and grant a Special Events Permit for the annual Knights of Columbus Tootsie Roll Drive on Friday, September 21, 2018 and Saturday, September 22, 2018 from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. at the corner of Webster and Main Cross upon receipt of a current Certificate of Insurance
- Motion to recommend to the City Council to allow Superintendent Wiseman to allow Vision Infrastructure Construction Corp. to do the pavement markings and arrows on Spresser Street from Webster Street to Cheney Street at a cost of \$6,054.12
- Motion to recommend to the City Council to allow Superintendent Wiseman to have Vandevanter Engineering replace the failed drive with an ABB Variable Frequency Drive complete with a keypad mounting kit at a cost of \$5,605.32, for the Pershing Road Lift Station
- Motion to recommend to the City Council to allow Superintendent Wiseman to have the old pump for the Henrietta Lift Station rebuilt by Vandevanter Engineering at a cost not to exceed \$5,484.53

Emergency Services –
