

Taylorville Municipal Band Committee

Minutes from Tuesday April 28, 2015

Jonathan Newlin called the meeting of the Taylorville Municipal Band Committee to order at 6:43 p.m. Those in attendance were Jonathan Newlin, president; Reggie Hohenstein, secretary; Jim Smith, director; Jan Phillips, manager; Martin Vota, aldermanic representative; and Taylorville Municipal Band Committee member Dennis Jones..

The minutes of the April 29, 2014 meeting were read. Jim made a motion to accept the minutes. Jonathan second and the motion carried.

Jan presented the tentative budget for the 2015 concert season.. There was discussion on added money for guest director(s) and operating supplies. The amount of \$520.00 will be needed to upgrade our lighting with 2 sets being replaced this year. Jim made a motion to accept the budget (pending approval by the city council) with a second from Reggie, and the motion carried.

Jan presented the dates for the 2015 concert season. The added jazz band rehearsal on Wednesday, July 1<sup>st</sup> will be added before the letter goes out to members. This letter will require a response by May 21<sup>st</sup> of intent of current members to return. After discussion of these dates, Jim made a motion to accept the concert season dates. Reggie second and the motion carried.

Our final agenda item was the hiring of the band director, band librarian, and band manager. After some discussion, Reggie, with a second from Jonathan, made a motion to rehire Jim Smith; Jonathan, with a second from Jim, made a motion to rehire Reggie Hohenstein; and Reggie, with a second from Jim, made a motion to rehire Jan Phillips for their respective positions of director, librarian, and band manager for the 2015 season. The rehiring of these positions was approved.

Also discussed was the vacancy on the Taylorville Municipal Band Committee. It was decided to table this item until Martin checks on the proper process.

With no further business coming before this committee, Jonathan adjourned at 7:16 p.m.
