

## OPEN BURNING UNTIL SEPTEMBER 30, 2025

After September 30<sup>th</sup>, burning is only permitted Monday through Sunday on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> full week of the month. This schedule remains until April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

- October 6<sup>th</sup> – October 12<sup>th</sup>
- October 20<sup>th</sup> – October 26<sup>th</sup>
- November 3<sup>rd</sup> – November 9<sup>th</sup>
- November 17<sup>th</sup> – November 23<sup>rd</sup>
- December 1<sup>st</sup> – December 7<sup>th</sup>
- December 15<sup>th</sup> – December 21<sup>st</sup>
- January 5<sup>th</sup> – January 11<sup>th</sup>
- January 19<sup>th</sup> – January 25<sup>th</sup>
- February 2<sup>nd</sup> – February 8<sup>th</sup>
- February 16<sup>th</sup> – February 22<sup>nd</sup>
- March 2<sup>nd</sup> – March 8<sup>th</sup>
- March 16<sup>th</sup> – March 22<sup>nd</sup>

The next open burn period is April 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

### **\*KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER\***

All fires must be attended at all times

Only leaves, vegetation, weeds, grass clippings or small tree limbs

Trash and trash barrel fires are not permitted

Burning is only permitted between the hours of 7am to dusk on the days previously mentioned.

Pay attention to weather conditions when burning

Be mindful of your neighbors

**Free Disposal:** Any resident within the corporate limits of the city may dispose of leaves, vegetation, weeds and grass clippings at no charge by hauling them, in yard waste containers or bags, to and depositing them into the designated receptacle(s) at the City Street and Sewer Department.
