Roll Call - Aldermen Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Jones, Lanzotti, Olive, and Walters reported present. Alderman Vota was absent.

YOUTH OF THE MONTH

Mayor Barry recognized the Taylorville FFA Livestock Judging Team as the Youth of the Month. The team competed at the National FFA Livestock Judging Competition in Denver, Colorado at the National Western Livestock show and became champions. This team of five students, consisting of Layne Lebshier, Tanner Mickey, Eric Schaefer, Lizzie Schafer, and Jett Vickery, will be representing the United States at the World Livestock Judging competition in Edinborough, Scotland this summer.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

OMNIBUS VOTE

PLAN COMMISSION RECOMMENDATIONS RE: SLOAN PROPERTY RE-ZONE

Acting Chairman Pat Kretzer noted that the Plan Commission was present during the Public Hearing regarding the Re-zone Application for property owned by Louis and Rebecca Sloan. The Plan Commission voted (4-0) to recommend to the City Council to adopt the Ordinance Amending the Zoning Classification of Certain Property.

ORDINANCE NO. 3885 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY (RE: LOUIS J. AND REBECCA L. SLOAN PROPERTY)

Motion by Alderman Walters and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to accept the Plan Commission recommendation and approve Ordinance No. 3885 - An Ordinance Amending the Zoning Classification of Certain Property (re: Louis J. and Rebecca L. Sloan Property). This will allow a portion of the property owned by the Sloan's, which had recently been re-zoned to AG-1, to be reclassified/zoned back to R-1. Roll Call - Aldermen Budd, Jones, Lanzotti, Olive, Walters, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. Aldermen Burtle and Dorchinecz voted NAY. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 3886 - AN ORDINANCE ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 6A TO THE TAYLORVILLE CITY CODE (RE: PROHIBITING ALTERNATIVE NICOTINE PRODUCTS TO MINORS)

Motion by Alderman Dorchinecz and seconded by Alderman Jones to approve Ordinance No. 3886 - An Ordinance Adding a New Chapter 6A to the Taylorville City Code (re: Prohibiting Alternative Nicotine Products to Minors). Roll Call - Aldermen Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Jones, Lanzotti, Olive, Walters, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

IL PROJECT NO. TAZ-4342 - CRAWFORD, MURPHY & TILLY

Motion by Alderman Lanzotti and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to authorize and direct the Mayor to sign Vendor Invoice No. 201888 for Airport Project No. TAZ-4342 in the amount of \$3,189.68 for professional services rendered from CMT and forward the request to the Illinois Department of Transportation for disbursement and approve payment of same pending receipt of disbursement. Roll Call - Aldermen Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Jones, Lanzotti, Olive, and Walters voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

WORKING FOREMAN POSITION IN SEWER DEPARTMENT

Motion by Alderman Walters and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to bid the position of Working Foreman in the Sewer Department. Roll Call - Aldermen Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Jones, Lanzotti, Olive and Walters voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.
