

At the regular meeting held in the Council Chambers by the City Council, July 20, 2020, the following proceedings were held and entered in this record in the following words and figures to wit:

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

The Invocation was given by Alderman Lee Lanzotti. Mayor Barry led the Council and the assembled group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety were present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Alderman Dorchinecz and seconded by Alderman Bryant to utilize the Omnibus Vote Designation for various meetings. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Driskell to approve the minutes of the Finance Committee Meeting held July 6, 2020; the Regular City Council Meeting held July 6, 2020; the Ordinance Committee Meeting held July 16, 2020; the Finance Committee Meeting held July 16, 2020. ORDINANCE NO. 3974 - AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO DEFRAY EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF TAYLORVILLE, CHRISTIAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING MAY 1, 2020 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2021

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Burtle to approve Ordinance No. 3974 - An Ordinance Making Appropriations to Defray Expenditures of the City of Taylorville, Christian County, Illinois for the Fiscal Year Commencing May 1, 2020 and Ending April 30, 2021. Clerk Lilly stated there was an error on the total of the Airport Fund but the total for that line was listed correctly on the Appropriation Summary page. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, Skultety, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 3975 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8-3-6 OF CHAPTER 3 TO TITLE 8 OF THE TAYLORVILLE CITY CODE (RE: INCREASING CEMETERY FEES)

Motion by Alderman Burtle and seconded by Alderman Bryant to approve Ordinance No. 3975 - An Ordinance Amending Section 8-3-6 of Chapter 3 to Title 8 of the Taylorville City Code (re: increasing cemetery fees). Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, Skultety, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 3976 - AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 8-3-8 OF CHAPTER 3 TO TITLE 8 OF THE TAYLORVILLE CITY CODE (RE: NO TRESPASSING)

Motion by Alderman Olive and seconded by Alderman Driskell to approve Ordinance No. 3976 - An Ordinance Adding Section 8-3-8 of Chapter 3 to Title 8 of the Taylorville City Code (re: no trespassing). This will allow signs to be placed at all entrances to Oakhill Cemetery. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, Skultety, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 3977 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPH i) OF PARAGRAPH J OF CHAPTER 9 TO TITLE 6 OF THE TAYLORVILLE CITY CODE (RE: ALLOWING UNLIMITED NUMBER OF UTVs)

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to approve Ordinance No. 3977 - An Ordinance Amending Subparagraph i) of Paragraph J of Chapter 9 to Title 6 of the Taylorville City Code (re: allowing unlimited number of UTVs). Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Dorchinecz, Lanzotti, Olive, Skultety, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. Aldermen Budd, Burtle, and Driskell voted NAY. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9-1-1 OF CHAPTER 1 TO TITLE 9 OF THE TAYLORVILLE CITY CODE (RE: BUILDING PERMITS)

Motion by Alderman Skultety and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to approve An Ordinance Amending Section 9-1-1 of Chapter 1 to Title 9 of the Taylorville City Code (re: building permits. City Attorney Romano stated that the Council would need to determine a dollar amount to charge for the fence permit. Currently there is a \$15 fee. Alderman Bryant suggested this be raised to a flat \$50.00 fee. HBO Goodall addressed the issue of temporary fence materials listed in the Ordinance; these should only be allowed for temporary/construction fences. Alderman Olive made a motion to table, with a second by Alderman Skultety, due to a temporary fence clause to be added to the Ordinance. The Ordinance will return to the Ordinance Committee for further review. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 3978 - AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF THE BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT (BDD) COMMERCIAL LEASE PAYMENT GRANT PROGRAM

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Bryant to approve Ordinance No. 3978 - An Ordinance Approving the Extension of the Business Development District(BDD) Commercial Lease Payment Grant Program. Mayor Barry noted that two applications were received one day after the deadline. This Ordinance allows for deadline to be extended to July 20, 2020 and will

then allow the City to reimburse those two property owners. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive and Mayor Barry voted YEA. Alderman Skultety voted NAY. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT - ANNUAL OLD TIMERS BOOGIE - AIRPORT

Motion by Alderman Dorchinecz and seconded by Alderman Budd to approve the Special Events Permit for the Annual Old-Timers Boogie at the Taylorville Municipal Airport from Friday, August 14, 2020 at 11:00 A.M. through Sunday August 16, 2020 at 8:00 P.M. Insurance has been provided. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

SALE OF PIERCE PUMPER FIRE ENGINE

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Budd to accept the high bid of \$2,600.00 for the Fire Engine in as is condition with no warranties; cash payment only. A local business owner made this high bid. Roll call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

ORDINANCE

828 WEST VANDEVEER DRIVEWAY

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Driskell to allow the driveway to be placed at the new home at 828 West Vandever. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

STOP SIGN - FAIRVIEW STREET

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to direct the City Attorney to prepare an Ordinance to amend the City Code to allow for a Stop Sign at the corner of Fairview Street. This is the entrance to the trailer park off of Houston Street. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti and Skultety voted YEA. Aldermen Budd and Olive voted NAY. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

NO PARKING THIS SIDE OF STREET - 311 WEST WILSON/HAWLEY STREET

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Olive to direct the City Attorney to prepare an Ordinance to amend the City Code to place No Parking This Side of Street signs from 311 West Wilson to the curve at the corner of Hawley Street. Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

SLOW-CHILDREN AT PLAY SIGNS - 3900 EAST LAKESHORE DRIVE

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Olive to direct the City Attorney to prepare an Ordinance to amend the City Code to place Slow-Children at Play signs on both sides of the road at 3900 East Lakeshore Drive. The motion carried (8-0).

FINANCE

EXTENSION OF SUMMER HELP

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Bryant to approve the extension of summer help to August 7, 2020 at an approximate cost to the City of \$7,000.00, to be paid out of the 2% Utility Tax Ward money. This extension will cover employees in the Lake, Street and Cemetery Departments. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Dorchinecz, Lanzotti, and Olive voted YEA. Aldermen Burtle, Driskell, and Skultety voted NAY. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

SEASONAL EMPLOYEE - LAKE DEPARTMENT

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Bryant to approve the hiring of a seasonal employee for the Lake Department for ten weeks to cover the potential staff vacancy based upon interdepartmental promotion. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

TWO PART TIME EMPLOYEES - LAKE MARINA

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Bryant to hire two part-time employees at the Lake Marina to be paid from the Lake Fund. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

PRIVATIZATION OF THE LAKE MARINA

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Driskell to forward the discussion of privatization of the Lake Marina to the Lake Committee. The motion carried (7-1).

TREASURER'S REPORT

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Burtle to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. The motion carried (8-0).

PAYMENT OF BILLS

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Burtle to authorize payment of bills. Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Olive to pull the Boat Dock refund check made

payable to Robbin Sheets as a right of set off of debt owed to the City. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Driskell, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

BUSINESS FROM THE PUBLIC

The Mayor asked if anyone in the audience wished to address the Council. No one present addressed the Council.

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Olive to adjourn. Motion carried (8-0).
