APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Alderman Olive and seconded by Alderman Budd to utilize the Omnibus Vote Designation to approve the minutes of various meetings. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

Motion by Alderman Dorchinecz and seconded by Alderman Bryant to approve Ordinance No. 3897 - An Ordinance to Rescind Ordinance No. 3892 (re: parking prohibition on South side of 400 block of West Poplar Street). Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 3898 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPH 9 OF PARAGRAPH A. OF SECTION 6-3-9 OF THE TAYLORVILLE CITY CODE

Motion by Alderman Skultety and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to approve Ordinance No. 3898 - An Ordinance Amending Subparagraph 9 of Paragraph A. of Section 6-3-9 of the Taylorville City Code (re: no parking to block use of driveways). Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Lanzotti, Olive, Skultety, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 3899 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 6-4-2 OF THE TAYLORVILLE CITY CODE

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Skultety to approve Ordinance No. 3899 - An Ordinance Amending 6-4-2 of the Taylorville City Code (i.e. designating yield right of way at Morton Street at intersection with Vine Street). Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Lanzotti, Olive, Skultety, and Mayor Barry voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT - TAYLORVILLE OPTIMIST CLUB

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Olive to approve the Special Events Permit for the Taylorville Optimist Club at the corner of Webster and Main Cross on Friday, June 14, 2019 from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. The motion carried (7-0).

SALE OF TAYLORVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT 1993 AMBULANCE

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Olive to accept the bid of \$5,205.00 cash from Mr. Shane Woods to purchase the Taylorville Fire Protection District 1993 Ford F-350 Type III Ambulance in it's "as is" condition and without any expressed or implied warranties or guarantees of any kind, nature, or extent whatsoever including, but not limited to, without any expressed or implied warranties, merchantability or fitness for a particular purchase, subject to approval of the TFPD Trustees. Roll Call - Aldermen Bryant, Budd, Burtle, Dorchinecz, Lanzotti, Olive, and Skultety voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

MAYOR UPDATES

The Mayor noted that the State of Illinois, due to the diligence of Senator Andy Manar, has awarded the City of Taylorville with a \$500,000.00 grant through the Illinois Emergency Management Association for disaster relief from the December 1, 2018 tornado.

#### SPECIAL EVENTS PERMIT - ANTIQUE AUTOMOBILE CLUB OF AMERICA

Motion by Alderman Olive and seconded by Alderman Dorchinecz to approve the request and issue a Special Events Permit to the Antique Automobile Club of America for the antique car show to be held on Saturday, June 29, 2019 beginning at 8:30 A.M. The motion carried (7-0).

#### FERRILL'S AG MANAGEMENT LLC - SPRAYING AT LAKE TAYLORVILLE

Motion by Alderman Olive and seconded by Alderman Budd to allow Superintendent Wiseman to hire Ferrill's Ag Management LLC to spray the South end of Lake Taylorville at County Road 8 at a cost not to exceed \$5,640.00, pending receipt of the City's form contract and requisite proof of insurance.
