Each reservation must be accompanied by the first night's camping fee plus a five (\$5.00) non-refundable reservation fee. Please make checks payable to the **City of Taylorville**. If your application does not include the correct fee, your check and application will be returned to you. Reservations will be taken **by mail only** beginning on the first working day in January of each year. After April 1st of each year, you may apply by mail, in person or by phone. Reservations are not final until written confirmation is provided by the City of Taylorville. **The balance MUST be paid in full upon arrival.**

The rent for an overnight camping site is **\$20.00 per night**. No pull through sites available. **Electricity and trash included. 30 Amp sites are 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 10, 11 & 12. 50 Amp sites are 4, 6, 7, & 9. A dump station is available west of the shower house.**

The City of Taylorville will not be held responsible for any personal items left behind.

Shower house/bathrooms are at the Marina. Swimming is allowed ONLY at the beach in the designated area, during season. (Memorial Day through Labor Day). Hours are posted. NO LIFE GUARDS ON DUTY. Please do not leave children unattended at the beach, restrooms or the Marina. Pets MUST be kept on a leash and NOT allowed on the beach.

Deposit/Cancellation Policy:

If a reservation is cancelled two (2) days before the arrival date, the cancelling party will receive the first night's fee, but the cancelling party will forfeit the non-refundable reservation fee. If a reservation is cancelled less than two (2) days before the arrival date, the cancelling party forfeits the first night's fee and the non-refundable fee. **Holiday weekend cancellations will forfeit the reservation fee and the first night's rental unless cancelled seven (7) days prior to the holiday weekend.**

No refunds for early departure.

Lake Superintendent reserves the right to remove any person(s) for violation of any lake rules.
