#### Personnel -

#### Water/Environmental -

- Motion to authorize and direct the Mayor to sign Pay Request #14 from Plocher Construction in the amount of \$1,043,100.00 for work on the New Water Treatment Plant and forward the request to IEPA Low Interest Loan Program for disbursement and approve payment of same pending receipt of disbursement from IEPA, this conditioned upon receipt of signed mechanics lien waivers in this amount and recommendation by the Project Engineer that the work has been satisfactorily performed
- Motion to recommend to the City Council to pay Benton & Associates \$55,177.03 for work performed related to the construction of the New Water Treatment Plant from July 22, 2018 through September 1, 2018

- Motion to recommend to the City Council to direct the City Attorney to prepare an Ordinance to sell A 2001 Kawasaki Mule
- Motion to recommend to the City Council to direct CMT to apply for the Consolidated Appropriations Act Grant
