Shower house/bathrooms are at the Marina. Swimming is allowed ONLY at the beach in the designated area, during season (Memorial Day through Labor Day). Hours are posted. NO LIFE GUARDS ON DUTY. Please do not leave children unattended at the beach, restrooms or the Marina. Pets MUST be kept on a leash and NOT allowed on the beach.

Deposit/Cancellation Policy:

If a reservation is cancelled two (2) days before the arrival date, the cancelling party will receive the first night's fee.
