SPECIAL TAYLORVILLE CITY COUNCIL MEETING Monday, December 27, 2021

At the Special Council Meeting held in the Council Chambers by the City Council, December 27, 2021 the following proceedings were held and entered in this record in the following words and figures to wit:

Mayor City Clerk

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.

Roll Call - Aldermen Brown, Bryant, Budd, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, and Wilson were present. Also present were Mayor Barry, City Attorney Romano (via Zoom), City Clerk Lilly, and City Treasurer Hamell.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE ANNUAL TAX LEVY FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON MAY 1, 2021 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2022

Mayor Barry opened the meeting and noted the only agenda item was the Tax Levy Ordinance.

Motion by Alderman Budd and seconded by Alderman Bryant to approve Ordinance No. 4088 – An Ordinance Making the Annual Tax Levy for Corporate Purposes for the Fiscal Year Commencing on May 1, 2021 and Ending April 30, 2022, for the City of Taylorville, Illinois.

Roll Call - Aldermen Brown, Bryant, Budd, Driskell, Olive, Skultety, and Wilson, along with Mayor Barry, voted YEA. The Mayor announced the motion carried.

City Attorney Romano noted that liquor stores are currently not allowed to sell liquor prior to 12:00 P.M. (noon) on Sunday. Currently only grocery stores and the golf course are able to sell early, beginning at 6:00 A.M. All other liquor license classifications are exempt. Mayor Barry would like to see the Code changed to include extended hours for convenience stores and liquor stores. This will be added to the City Council Agenda for Tuesday, January 4, 2021.

Mayor Barry also presented a quote from Petersburg Plumbing & Excavating for sewer work on East Palmer Street for \$20,568.00. There is a very large sinkhole which requires action. This will also be placed on the City Council Agenda.

Motion by Alderman Bryant and seconded by Alderman Budd to adjourn. Motion carried (7-0).
